Operator terms allow you to narrow down your search in more targeted ways.

**Wildcard Searches** use the \* symbol as a place holder for another word. They are useful when you don't know the full text of a quote.

Combination Searches uses the OR operator, allowing you to search for 2 or more terms at the same time. Another way to form a combination search is using the word AND.

Search a Specific Site is when you type site: (followed by the URL of the website you wish to search) and a search term. This limits your search to a single website.

Finding Related Sites is another useful operator related to the search a specific site method.
